Recommendations 4/6

- Putting emphasis on services requires taking into account the following aspects: sustainable funding, catalogues of services and underpinning information, segmenting user categories, re-thinking data collection, packaging and dissemination from a user perspective rather than a producer one;
- A sustainable SDI needs not only top-down coordination but also bottom-up implementation. This requires a recognition of local diversity and organizational capacity to deploy the support mechanism necessary to meet common objectives.

Description of Work

TRANSDI project builds a thematic network made by critical mass of GI Geographic Information experienced organisations (mainly SDIs *Spatial Data Infrastructures* and SDICs *Special Data Interest Communities*), to increase the awareness of the benefits of using geographic information and spatial data infrastructures, digitally enriched by semantically well defined metadata and by their intelligent usage within the Public Administration. By a consistent 2 years dissemination plan, it will play a strong coordination activity and structured dissemination among partners generating knowledge and consensus across Europe while using best practices and solutions (implemented and/or under development at national and regional level) to demonstrate and to disseminate the intelligence of using appropriate and semantically defined information and
